Conform acestei proceduri, sesiunea de transfer în semestrul al II-lea, pentru studenții internaționali, se realizează astfel:

- Cap. V1-Art. 31 (3): în cazul mobilității solicitate înainte de semestrul II al anului universitar, cererea trebuie însoțită de situația școlară care dovedește promovarea în integralitate a tuturor disciplinelor aferente semestrului I, conform planurilor de învățământ ale fiecărei instituții. ***Solicitarea poate fi aprobată doar cu condiția existenței unui acord interinstituțional.***

Drept urmare, vă rugăm să consultați lista cu parteneriatele internaționale prezentată mai jos.

Dacă universitatea dumneavoastră nu se regăsește în această listă, nu puteți aplica pentru transfer în această sesiune.

Vă așteptăm în sesiunea de transfer din septembrie 2026, sesiune în care nu se vor aplica aceleași prevederi.

According to this procedure, the transfer session in the second semester for international students is carried out as follows:

- Chapter V1-Art. 31 (3): in the case of mobility requested before the second semester of the academic year, the application must be accompanied by the academic record proving the full promotion of all subjects related to the first semester, according to the curricula of each institution. ***The request can only be approved if there is an inter-institutional agreement.***

Therefore, please consult the list of international partnerships posted below.

If your university is not on this list, you cannot apply for transfer during this session.

We look forward to seeing you in the September 2026 transfer session, during which the same provisions will not apply.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE CONTENTS OF THE FILE

The file of a foreign/Romanian citizen who has studied in another country must contain the following documents, in two copies:

1. Transfer application (Annex);
2. Personal application and statement with the list of documents submitted in the file (Annex);
3. Affidavit for the authenticity of the documents (Annex);
4. High school diploma or equivalent diploma
 - in original together with a copy and certified translation, endorsed for authentication by the Romanian Embassy in the issuing country or apostilled in The Hague, for foreign applicants from non-EU countries;
 - in original together with a copy and certified translation, for citizens of EU, EEA, and EC member states;
5. Certificate of recognition of studies or application for the issuance of the certificate, for citizens of the EU, EEA, and EC The evaluation fee (<http://www/cnred/edu/ro/>) can be paid by payment order or postal order to the account below:

6. Application for the issuance of the Letter of Acceptance for studies for foreign applicants from non-EU;
7. Transcript of studies completed at the university of origin (academic record) in original, together with a certified translation (one copy);
8. Original transcripts of the study program completed at the higher education institution of origin, together with a certified translation (one copy);
9. Authorized certificate of proficiency in the language of study;
10. Certified copy of birth certificate, together with certified translation (for certificates issued in other countries);
11. Copy of pages 1-4 of passport or other identity document;
12. Medical certificate form M/S/ 18/1/1/ (and certified translation), issued by school medical offices or family doctors - as applicable - to which they belong (stating that they are fit for the field or program of study for which they are applying) / The certificate shall be accompanied by the results of medical investigations regarding pulmonary radiology and blood serology (VDRL) / Foreign applicants are required to submit a medical certificate valid for a maximum of 6 months;
13. Notarized power of attorney clearly specifying its date of validity (for those who do not submit their files in person);
14. Copy of the receipt for the analysis of the transfer file;
15. Copy of the registration receipt, after acceptance of the Academic Mobility (Transfer);
16. GDPR statement.
